rpm

Syntax	Description
rpm -i <package_name>.rpm</package_name>	Installs a new package or updates it if it's already installed.
rpm -U <package></package>	Upgrades a package. If it's not installed, it will install it.
rpm -F <package_name></package_name>	Upgrades a package only if it's already installed.
rpm -e <package_name></package_name>	Removes (erases) a package.
rpm -qa	Lists installed packages.
rpm -qi <package_name></package_name>	Displays info about the package (query info).
rpm -ql <package_name></package_name>	Displays files installed by the package (query list).
rpm -qip <package_name>.rpm</package_name>	Displays info about the package that's not currently installed.
rpm -qlp <package_name>.rpm</package_name>	Displays files that will be installed if you decide to install a package.
<pre>rpm -qf /path/to/file</pre>	Displays the package to which the specified file belongs to.

yum

Syntax	Description
yum search <package_name></package_name>	Searches for a package.
yum install <package_name></package_name>	Installs a package.
yum update <package_name></package_name>	Updates specific package to its latest version.
yum update	Updates all the installed packages to their latest version.
yum whatprovides <file_name></file_name>	Finds a package that provides file name specified.
yum info <package_name></package_name>	Provides info about the package.
yum repolist all	Shows all available repositories.

yum-config-manager

Syntax	Description
yum-config-manageradd-repo https://example.com/repo	Adds a repository from a specified URL.
yum-config-managerenable repository	Enables a repository.
yum-config-manager –disable repository	Disables a repository.
